Dear Parents/Carers

You may have seen in the local press this week articles regarding the proposed building of a new Sainsburys in Newmarket. This forms part of some wider, ambitious proposals for developing a whole range of amenities in the town. We are delighted to be able to share with you that we have been working with the developers to secure some wonderful opportunities to make a real investment in the future of Newmarket College and our students. The plans that will going to consultation include:

- The redevelopment of the College field into a first class school and community sports complex.
- An inspiring brand new Sixth Form Centre for the College with state of the art facilities for post 16 education in the 21st century.

Please do come into the College on Tuesday 19th July from 3pm until 6pm to see the plans for these new developments at Newmarket College and ask questions of the developers.

The College field will be leveled to provide for full winter and summer use and will include an all-weather pitch and brand new changing rooms for use by the College, the sports clubs and the wider community in Newmarket. We believe that this major investment enables us to support community sport in the heart of Newmarket. We will be able to grow strong links with the sports clubs of Newmarket and inspire our young people to take up sporting activities after and beyond school.

The developers are working to secure sponsorship for the Sixth Form Centre to be built as part of this development project. We are very excited by the prospect of adding a 21st century learning environment of our sixth form students. It will be an inspiration for our young people and will help us to secure high quality Post 16 education in Newmarket. We can see that the new centre and state of the art facilities will be also be available to the wider community in Newmarket.

During the next week, there will be other opportunities for you to see the plans and talk to the developers, as part of the Consultation. There are also some public exhibitions planned on Friday 22nd July from 2pm until 7pm at Newmarket Leisure Centre and from 10am until 4pm at the Rutland Arms Hotel on Saturday 23rd July.
